

**RICEWOOD MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT  
NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a regular public meeting **via telephone conference call** pursuant to Texas Government Code, Section 551.125, as amended, and as modified by the temporary suspension of various provisions thereof effective March 16, 2020, by the Governor of Texas in accordance with the Texas Disaster Act of 1975, all as related to the Governor's proclamation on March 13, 2020, certifying that the COVID-19 pandemic poses an imminent threat of disaster and declaring a state of disaster for all counties in Texas. **The telephone conference call phone number is 1-877-304-9269 and the access code is 718863#.** All members of the public may participate in the meeting via telephone conference call

The meeting will be held on **Tuesday, October 20, 2020, at 12:00 Noon.**


The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action necessary or appropriate with respect to or related to same:

1. Call to order, including explanation of telephone conference call meeting procedures;
2. Public comments;
3. Approval of the minutes of the Board meeting of September 15, 2020;
4. Tax Assessor-Collector report, including authorizing payment of invoices presented, approving moving of accounts to uncollectible roll, status of collection of delinquent taxes, and authorizing lawsuit and/or foreclosure, as appropriate;
5. Conduct a public hearing regarding the adoption of the District's 2020 tax rate;
6. Levy of the District's 2020 debt service and maintenance tax rates, and the adoption of an Order in connection therewith;
7. Approval and execution of an Amendment to the Third Amended and Restated District Information Form;
8. Engagement of auditor to audit the District's financial statements and prepare the District's audit report for fiscal year ending September 30, 2020;
9. Delinquent Tax Report, including discussing legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney, and authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
10. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports, and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
11. Status of compliance by the District with Texas Government Code, Chapter 2265, relative to energy reporting; and authorize any action in connection therewith;

12. Landscape Maintenance Report, including the general maintenance of park and recreational facilities;
13. Engineering Report, including:
  - a. Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for the construction of facilities within the District, and approving of related storm water plans;
  - b. Authorizing the award of construction contracts for the construction of facilities within the District, accepting any related TEC Form 1295s, and approving any related storm water permits;
  - c. Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any pay estimates and/or change orders in connection therewith, including:
    - (i) Lift Station Rehabilitation project; and
    - (ii) Lift Station Recoating project;
  - d. Status of proposed capital improvement plan for maintenance and rehabilitation of Mayde Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant and Lift Station; and
  - e. Issuance of utility commitments, and authorize acceptance of TEC Forms 1295;
14. Ratify prior action to approve the Consent to Assumption of Service Agreement by Vogler & Spencer Engineering;
15. Status of West Harris County Regional Water Authority offer to purchase of a water line easement from the District;
16. Discuss the Joint Operations Committee meeting for the Wastewater Treatment Plant;
17. Operation and Maintenance Report, including:
  - a. Termination of delinquent accounts;
  - b. Forwarding delinquent accounts to collection agency, and the taking of any action in connection therewith; and
  - c. Compliance with permits and regulatory requirements, including review of any notices of violations, responses to notices and remedial action taken, self-reporting forms as and if required, and correspondence to and from regulatory agencies regarding same;
18. Report regarding security patrol in the District;
19. Communications Consulting Report by Touchstone District Services;
20. Annual review of Order Establishing Policy for Investment of District Funds and Appointing Investment Officer, and adoption of Resolution and amended Order in connection therewith;
21. Discussion regarding America' Water Infrastructure Act of 2018 and memorandum regarding same;

22. Review of the Annual Maintenance for Arbitrage Analysis Report by Municipal Risk Management Group, LLC;
23. Attorney's Report, including notice from the West Harris County Regional Water Authority regarding a proposed fee increase for 2021;
24. Discussion regarding electronic water meters, including presentations and consideration of proposals regarding same; and
25. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
